Due to COVID-19 updates continually changing, Xtreme Dance Studio periodically reviews and updates our policies as needed.

STUDIO TOURS BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

STUDIO | LOBBY NOW OPEN

- Studio and lobby are now open. Please have dancers enter through main studio door to navigate to their studio.
- Front Desk staff will be available for limited hours each day. Dance families will be emailed a schedule.
- No cash payments available at this time.



Wearing masks while entering/exiting the studio or while dancing at the studio are optional and up to the discretion of dancer and/or family.



Each dancer will have hand sanitizer sprayed on their hands upon entry and exiting. Hand sanitizer will be available in the studio.

BREAKS | Students may sit in the lobby during their breaks, but there may not be supervision. Students must be able to sit without supervision. Staff will be in studios teaching.

If anyone is experiencing a fever or feels ill, PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE STUDIO

POSITIVE CASES AT XTREME:

Xtreme Dance Studio will immediately respond to a positive COVID case or student/staff exposure using the following guidelines:

If a student or staff member has been diagnosed with COVID-19:

- An email will be sent to all dancers who has/had class with that individual. Confidentiality will be respected and the individual's name will be kept private.
- Dancers may return to class after 5 days with a negative COVID test, or 7 days without any test or symptoms or may choose to return so long as the dancer remains asymptomatic.
- Any person or staff that was not within 6ft or direct contact will not be required to quarantine. This may include the instructor. Each instance will be evaluated for each occurrence.
- Any individual who has a fever 100.4 or higher (but not COVID symptoms) will be required to stay home for a minimum of 72 hours to evaluate their symptoms. Rapid tests are available at Advent Health Urgent Cares facilities.
- All equipment is cleaned and disinfected between each class.

If you have been exposed outside the studio to COVID, you can choose to quarantine for a period of time not to exceed 7 days from last date of contact with the COVID positive individual. OR Parents/guardians can allow the dancer to return to dance so long as the student remains asymptomatic.

Xtreme Dance Studio will be following guidelines followed by Seminole County Public Schools. If a dancer is not required to quarantine at school, then they will not be required to by Xtreme.
